	<p>September 28, 2012 at or about 1011hrs, I responded to 980 Happy Hollow Road, referencing a complaint of a man locked in a bedroom, threatening to harm himself. Upon arrival, I spoke with Ms. Connie Hart and her sister Mrs Delores Ellison. Ms. Hart advised that she and her boyfriend, James Bullock, were arguing and Mr. Bullock had locked himself in his bedroom. I attempted to make contact with Mr. Bullock. At this time, Ms. Hart advised that he had weapons in the room with him. At this time, I directed Ms. Hart and Mrs. Ellison to retreat with me to the outside of the residence. I then notified dispatch of the situation and requested assistance from other officers. While waiting for other officers to arrive, Ms. Hart advised that she and Mr. Bullock were arguing about a cable bill they had received from their cable provider. She explained that she told Mr. Bullock she was tired of arguing and left the residence. She advised that she walked to Mrs Ellison's residence to "cool off". She stated the time was approximately 0930hrs. Upon her return to the residence, Ms. Hart advised that she went to the bedroom door and knocked, in an attempt to talk to Mr. Bullock. She stated their was no response from his bedroom. At this time, she called the Pike County Sheriff's Office. At or about 1028hrs Major Jeremy Masters and Dputy Hank Steiger arrived on the scene. I advised them of the situation. All three officers made entry into the residence. Major Masters attempted to make contact with the Mr. Bullock and received no response. We decided to make entry into the bedroom. Once entry was made, we discovered Mr. Bullock lying on his bed and was deceased from a single gun shot wound to his chest. At this time we investigated the contents of the bedroom and found the door was barricaded (see photos). In addition, we found a 12guage, K-Mart model, single shot gun laying in the bed with Mr. Bullock. There was one expired round in the chamber of the weapon. Upon further investigation, we found the windows to be securely locked. This lead us to the conclusion, the wound was self-inflicted by Mr. Bullock. I immediately secured the weapon in my patrol unit. After this discovery, Major Masters and I approached Ms. Hart and notified her, that Mr. Bullock was dead. I then notified dispatch and requested an ambulance and a coroner to assist us on the scene. At or about 1100, Pike County Squad #1 arrived on the scene. The medical staff was Thomas Arthur and Ed Reed. I requested an ambulance service, in order to confirm Mr. Bullock showed no signs of life and to attend to Ms. Hart. Ms. Hart was at an elevated emotional state and her vital signs need to be monitored. She did, in fact, check out not be at any medical risk. at this time, I spoke with Brett Bullock, the oldest son and next of kin to Mr. James Bullock. His instructions for the care of his father's body were to have his father transported to a local funeral home and that Mr. Bullock was to be cremated. At or about 1200, the Pike County Coroner (Dr. Kessler) arrived on the scene. Dr. Kessler examined the victim and officially pronounced the subject to, in fact, be dead. At this time, Dr. Kessler notified Boyer Funeral home and requested their services, in order to remove the body. Upon the arrival of the funeral home staff, they immediately removed Mr. Bullock's body from the scene. After which, the ambulance team and myself proceeded to removed all bed linens. During the removal of the bed linens, we discovered a loaded 9mm hand gun lying under the blankets and pillows next to Mr. Bullock. I secured the weapon in my patrol unit. I cleared the scene at 1317hrs. Upon my return to the Pike County Sheriff's office, I entered the two weapons into evidence and into the control of Deputy David Roosa.</p>
